1) **Determine your partner**

- a) It should be someone that had had interviewing experience
- b) Find a job listing and use that as the position you are applying for

2) **Partner Up**

- a) Find a partner, someone with interviewing experience. Introduce yourself to your partner as if you were approaching someone from a company. You can invent a company or use one that already exists.

3) **Introduce yourself**

- a) You have 30-45 seconds to introduce yourself
- b) You can use a stopwatch to time yourself.
- c) Make sure you include your name, high school, area of study, industry of interest for future, and an experience or fact that qualifies you for the position

4) **Interview**

- a) Have your partner ask you questions
- b) Pretend that this is a real interview and have your partner ask you some of the example questions

5) **Activity Wrap-up**-Answers per question.

- a) How did it feel to introduce yourself?
- b) What was challenging?
- c) What was easy about it?
- d) Mention some of these tips as takeaways for this activity:
- e) Be confident; no one knows you better than you
- f) Make eye contact
- g) Give a firm hand shake
- h) Speak up and speak clearly
